Community Information Days for Proposed Traveston Crossing Dam EIS

Queensland Water Infrastructure (QWI) Pty Ltd is to hold another round of Community Information Days associated with the proposed Traveston Crossing Dam Environmental Impact Statement (EIS).

Community members are invited to attend Information Days at Maryborough and Amamoor from 11am to 3pm.

The Maryborough Information Day will be held at the Brolga Theatre lawns, Walker Street on Saturday 9 June 2007 and will be followed by the Amamoor Information Day on Sunday 10 June 2007 at 1825 Mary Valley Road, Amamoor, near Gympie.

The Information Days follow similar events which were held during the public comment period of the draft Terms of Reference in December 2006 and January 2007.

The Community Information Day will be attended by project team members and will include information on some of the technical studies being undertaken as part of the EIS.

Members of the community will have the opportunity to speak with project team members to ask questions or seek clarification on posted information. There will also be the opportunity for community members to provide feedback to the EIS team.
